

#### ROADMAP IMPLEMENTATION REQUIRES DEVELOPING PROCESSES TO ACCESS SUPPORT AND COUNTRY GUIDANCE

- Key objective is to encourage multi-sectoral implementation, provide countries with guidance on NCPs, and ensure strong monitoring of national cholera programmes
  - Two workstreams will be undertaken to focus on the:
    - Practical guidance to countries and partners on NCP development, implementation, and monitoring
    - GTFCC Process to receive, review, and endorse NCPs

#### **RECOMMENDED NCP DEVELOPMENT PROCESS** GTFCC partners can support countries throughout the process



## SITUATIONAL ANALYSIS CONSISTS OF TWO COMPONENTS— (I) CHOLERA RISK ASSESSMENT



Minimum 5 year review, including:

- Epidemiological curves
- Number of cases and deaths
- Outbreak frequency, magnitude, severity
- Susceptibility of population



Identify and map all hotspots within a country and plot on a map


# EVALUATE CONTEXTUAL

- Risk of spread mobility, weather
  patterns, special populations, health
  seeking behaviors
- Assessment of WASH practices

## SITUATIONAL ANALYSIS CONSISTS OF TWO COMPONENTS— (II) ASSESSMENT OF EACH PILLAR

Identifies current activities, capacities, and funding

## SITUATIONAL ANALYSIS FEEDS INTO NCP DEVELOPMENT




Establish multi-sectoral cholera program

## **GTFCC ENDORSEMENT PROCESS**



#### TIMELINES AND CONSULTATION

- A sub-set of individuals from each WG, including partners and countries, will be asked to provide detailed feedback
- High level consultation with each GTFCC WGs via email or annual meetings
- Draft document circulated for feedback in February 2019
- Institutional buy-in to be collected and finalized in May 2019
- All documents will be finalized at the annual June 2019 meeting via GTFCC validation with planned dissemination by early July 2019
