

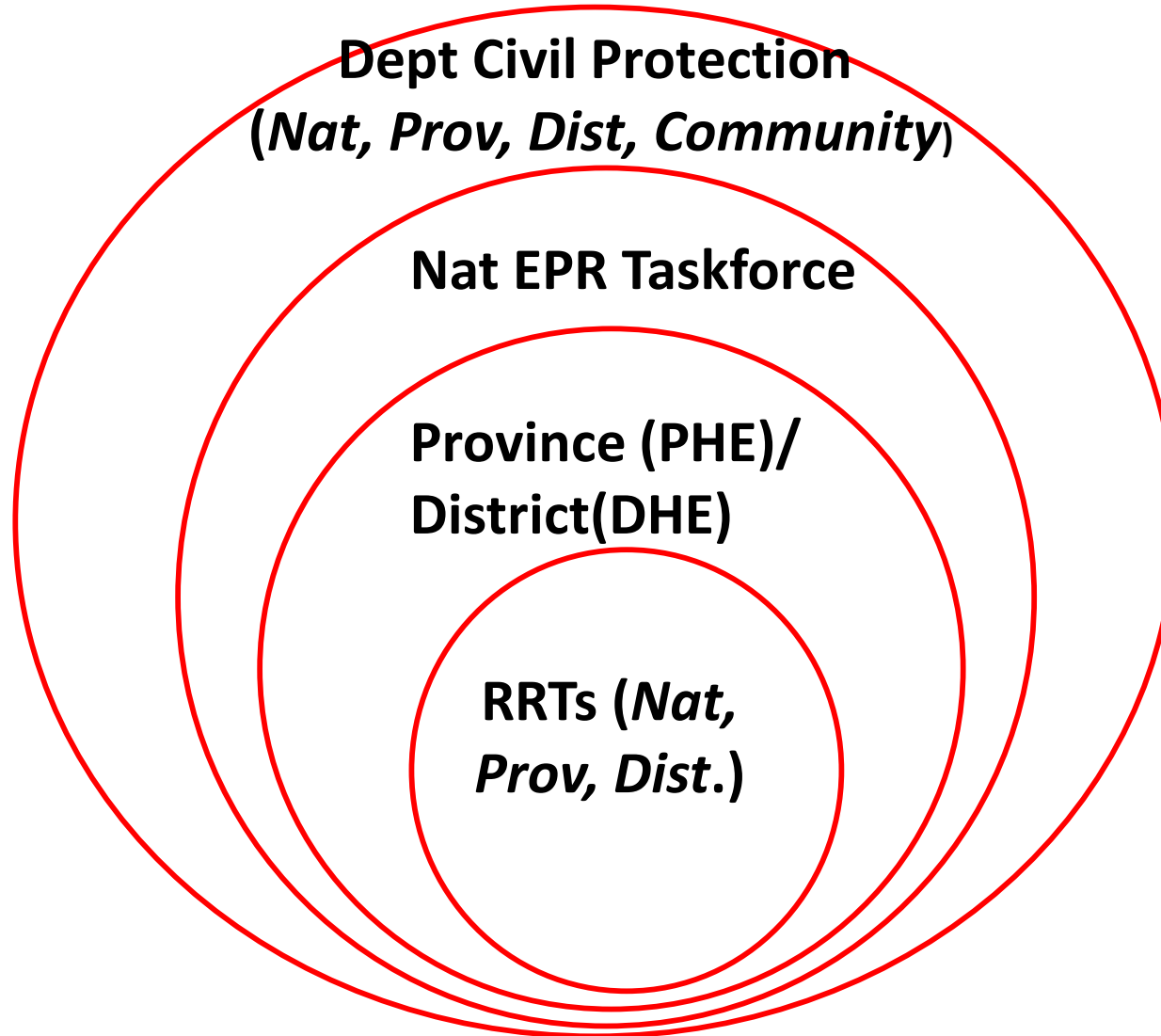

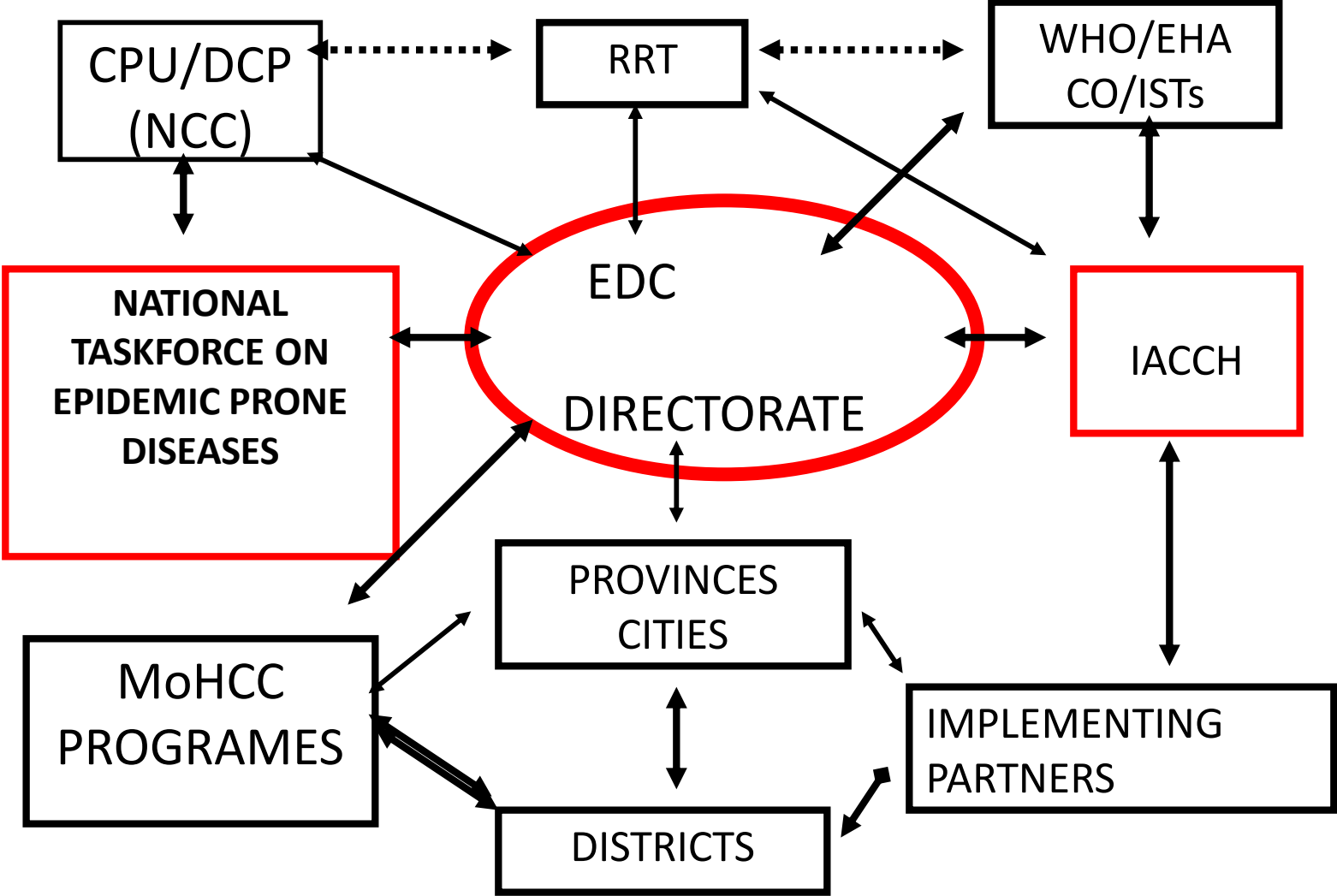
Operational Framework

- The MOHCC is responsible for management of all health emergencies and disasters
 - An established coordination mechanism for partners (IACCH)
 - The national task force on epidemic prone diseases (MOHCC, City Health).
- The Department of Civil Protection
 - Local Authorities
- Partners play critical roles
 - UN agencies, NGO's, and Donors, *individuals*.

Coordination Mechanisms: RRTs



EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT OPERATIONAL FRAMEWORK



Capacity Building

- Health workers trained in EPR, RRT and Integrated disease surveillance and response (IDSR)
- Health workers trained in management of emerging & re-emerging infectious diseases; (***Cholera, Measles, Typhoid, H1N1, Ebola...Zika***)
 - Rapid Response Teams
 - Setting up of temporary isolation, treatment centers
 - Health information & data management during crises
 - Case management

Coordination mechanism's

During “peace” times

- Rapid Response Teams (Local, District, Provincial & National)
- Inter Agency Coordination Committee on Health (National Level)
- Epidemic Response Committees (All levels)
- Civil Protection (All levels)

On declaration of national emergency:

- Inter-Ministerial committee – all relevant ministries
- Working Part of Senior Officials – corresponding permanent secretaries
