


Progress ins last years

Country perspective using Combined Strategy – OCV and WASH



- Rapid access to the global stockpile allows a better complementarity of strategies;
- The complementarity of the strategies allows a greater sustainability of the systems (from surveillance to case management).

Support expected from GTFCC

- Reinforcement of surveillance (enhanced systems);
- Support to establish a coordination mechanism in cholera initiatives;
