NIGERIA OCV CAMPAIGNS

- OCV was used for the first time in Nigeria in 2017 to control outbreaks in Borno State
- 6 LGAs in Borno State were vaccinated with 914, 565 doses
- Desk review of historical data (2012-2017) resulted in the identification of 105 high risk LGAs (Cholera hotspots mapping) in July, 2018
- A national vaccination calendar targeting all 105 LGAs for 9 phases campaigns from 2018-2022 was developed
- By July 2018 3,107,947 doses were used to control cholera in 3 states in a reactive context (Yobe, Bauchi & Adamawa)
- A total of 2,684,868 persons in 10 LGAs were targeted with 5,369,738 doses for 2 rounds in 2018

PERSPECTIVE OF OCV USE/PLANS FOR THE FUTURE


- Perceived impact: No evaluation done yet for campaigns held (Impact and effectiveness). However a concept note to address this gap is being developed
 - Dearth of funds and standardized tools for OCV impact assessment
- Campaigns were mostly implemented at the end of outbreaks due to lengthy process involved in applications for OCV
- Security compromised areas have proven difficult to be effectively targeted
- Acceptance: Acceptance is moderate especially among adult population and Muslim communities
- Plans for the future
 - Early application to the GTFCC/GAVI for vaccines and operational funds to continue originally planned campaigns
 - Funds/Grants for operational research
 - Strengthened coordination among stakeholders
 - Strengthened surveillance, laboratory, case management, risk communication and WASH capacities
 - GTFCC technical and financial support in implementing the 5 year National Strategic Plan of Action

INTEGRATION OF OCV WITH WASH PROJECT

- •NCDC has developed a National Strategic Plan of Action on Cholera Control: 2018-2023
- The FMWR has developed the PEWASH program in 2017. The program aims at improving water supply by 100% by 2030 and eliminate open defecation by 2025
- •Also the FMWR has developed a National WASH Action Plan for the Country which was launched on November 8, 2018
- The National Strategy for ODF in Nigeria was launched in May 2019 with the theme "clean Nigeria, use the **Toile**t"
- •A total of 22 LGAs have being validated and certified ODF (Cross River, Bauchi, Kaduna, Katsina)
- •70 solar power bore hole SPBH and 5HP project is still on-going and about 70% of the projects has been completed (2019)
- Contract awarded for construction of 107 sanitation facilities in 11 States
- WASH activities are conducted during OCV campaigns supported by partners

Nigeria: LGAs/States affected by Cholera, Wks 01-52, 2017-18 & Wk01-20 2019






Affected: LGAs = 247; States = 30
