

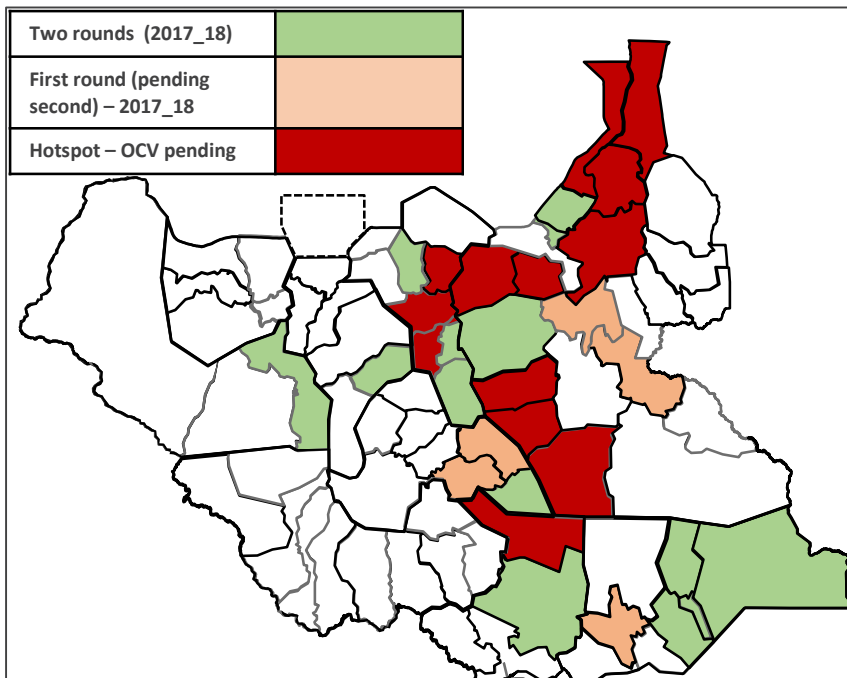
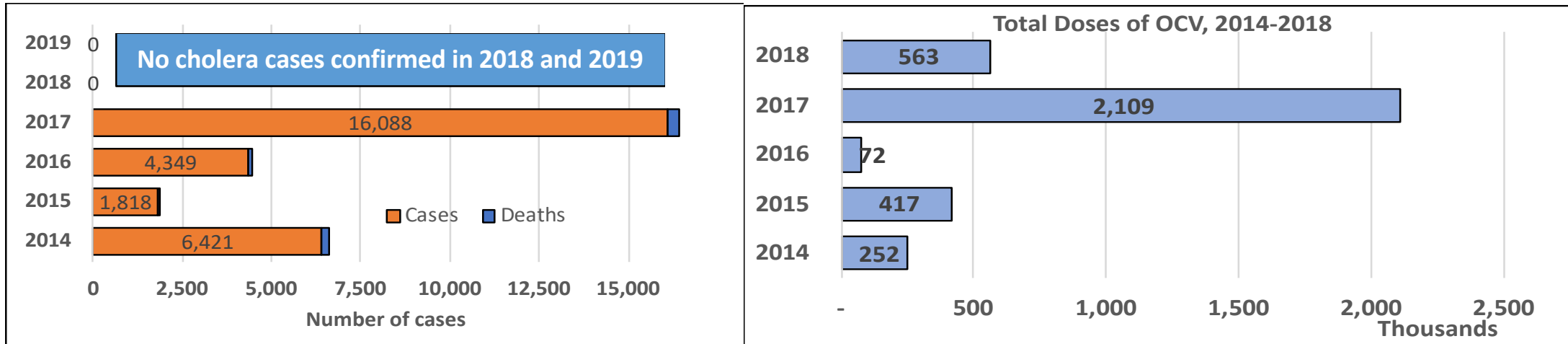


# COUNTY PROGRESS AND PERSPECTIVES FOR CHOLERA CONTROL IN SOUTH SUDAN

# CHOLERA IN SOUTH SUDAN



1. **Cholera started** soon after crisis onset in **Dec 2013**
2. From **2014-2017** at least **28,676 cases** & **644 deaths** reported
3. Comprehensive response (**3.4 million** doses of **OCV deployed** to hotspots [2014-18])
4. **No new cholera** cases **confirmed** in **2018** & **2019**

# PERSPECTIVES ON CHOLERA CONTROL

- Draft National Cholera Control Plan (NCCP) developed
  - Profiling of cholera hotspots based on GTFCC guidance
  - GTFCC consultant secured May 2019 – WASH profiling in hotspot areas for tailored medium and long term interventions
  - Draft NCCP review, validation, costing to follow
  - Cholera stakeholders meeting planned for June 2019
- A total of 2.9 million doses approved in April 2019 for preventive vaccination campaigns in cholera hotspots

# SUPPORT EXPECTED FROM GTFCC

1. Continued support towards – completing WASH profiling and prioritization in cholera hotspots
2. Support in country review, validation, & costing the NCCP
3. GTFCC review and endorsement of NCCP
4. NCCP launch, resource mobilization, strengthening implementation coordination, laboratory capacities
5. Access the approved 2.9 million OCV doses to implement preventive campaigns and WASH
