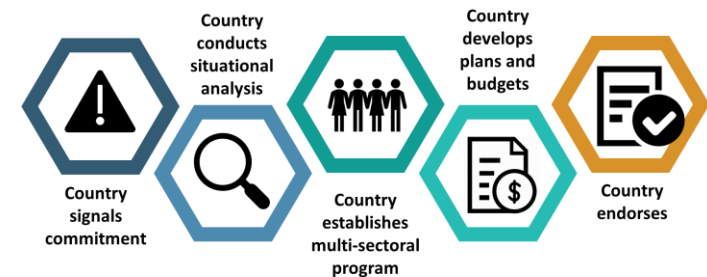
- Co-organize Global **GTFCC Annual meetings**, in coordination with partners and in accordance with GTFCC priorities and strategies
