#### **Assess impact**

- Support of modeling efforts to generate global estimates
- Understanding epidemiology in endemic areas.

- Successful WHO-PQ of oral cholera vaccine
- Low-cost Gavi-eligible vaccine
- Euvichol-plus FS, Shanchol CTC

- Revitalization of the GTFCC Secretariat.
- Advocacy for cholera control; Stop Cholera.
- GTFCC Roadmap released in 2017 outlining use case of vaccine in preventative targeting.
- 36 million doses of OCV used since 2013.
- 26 countries requested OCV (11 GTFCC, 15 ICG mechanism).










#### SHIFTS IN CHOLERA






#### **Strategic Options**




 Due to the immediate need of OCV requests outstripping supply and our BMGF competitive advantage, increasing OCV supply by partnering with manufacturers is our top priority.

#### 1 - UNDERSTANDING EPIDEMIOLOGY


- Identify cholera hotspots through geomapping incidence and conducting of sero-surveys for recent cholera exposure
- Partner organizations:
  - John's Hopkins University, School of Public Health
  - International Centre for Diarrheal Disease Research, Bangladesh
  - Mass General Hospital, Partners in Health





#### 2 – OPTIMIZE MARKET DYNAMICS

- Our objective is to optimize existing vaccines, using innovations such as re-formulation of the current vaccine, single-prefilled compact delivery devices and labeling for controlled temperature chain to enable ease of access to target populations.
- We are engaging to optimize production efficiencies and expand manufacturing capacity given the growing demand for OCV
- We are working with WHO GTFCC to standardize the NCCP process and improve OCV demand forecasts
- Partner organizations:

  - Manufacturers
  - MMGH
  - Gavi



## 3 - ENABLE, SCALE AND DELIVERY, ASSESS IMPACT

- We will continue to support the GTFCC Secretariat to lead the global implementation of the #ENDCHOLERA Roadmap and shift from outbreak to preventive use of OCV
- Our focus over the next 3 years is to ensure continued funding for OCV
  - including operational expenses through the Gavi replenishment
- We are exploring options with other funding organizations to support country-focused efforts:
  - Expand knowledge around burden, interventions and the path to elimination
  - Engage with countries to develop, mobilize resources and execute NCCPs
  - Demonstrate impact by tracking hotspots post-interventions and over time
- We encourage surveillance and WaSH funders and advocacy organizations to contribute to the Global Roadmap elimination strategy
