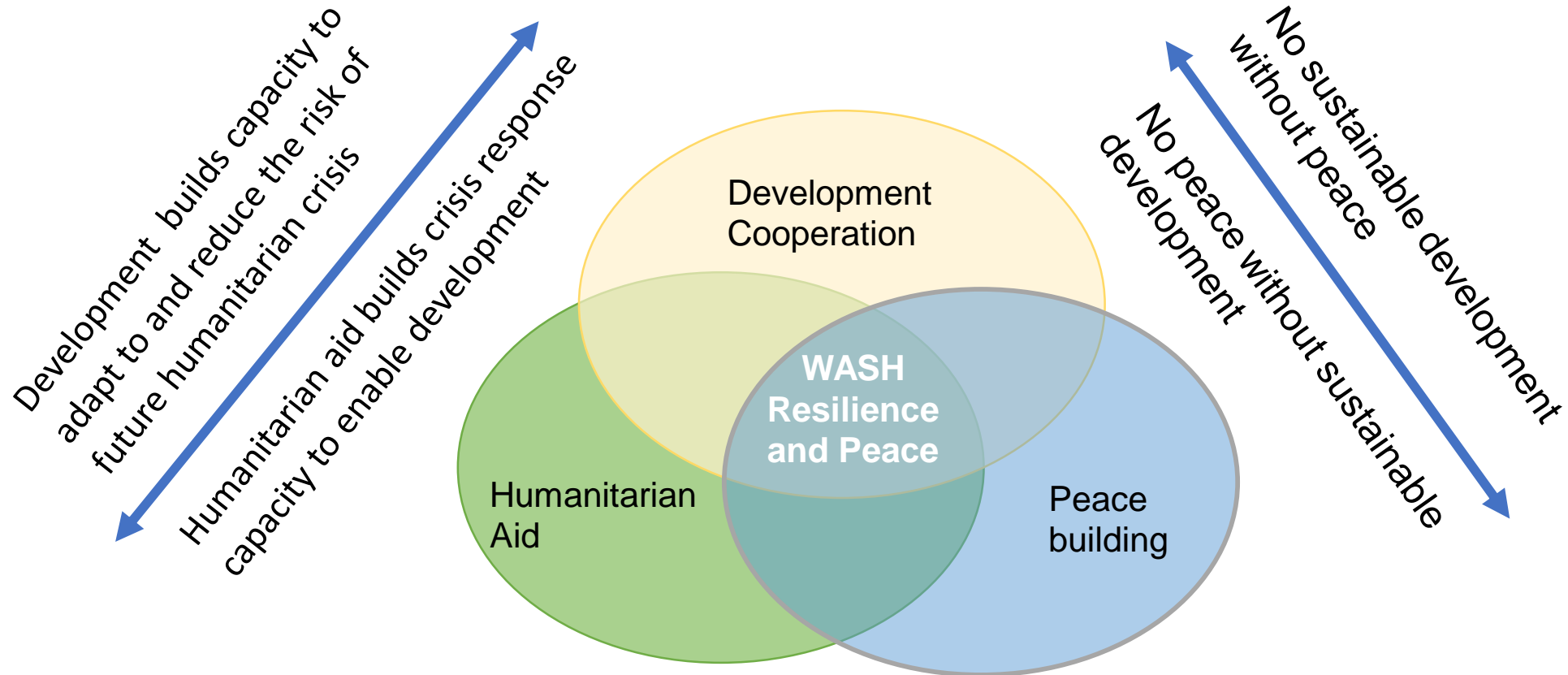

Humanitarian aid brings the resources for peace (while remaining independent)

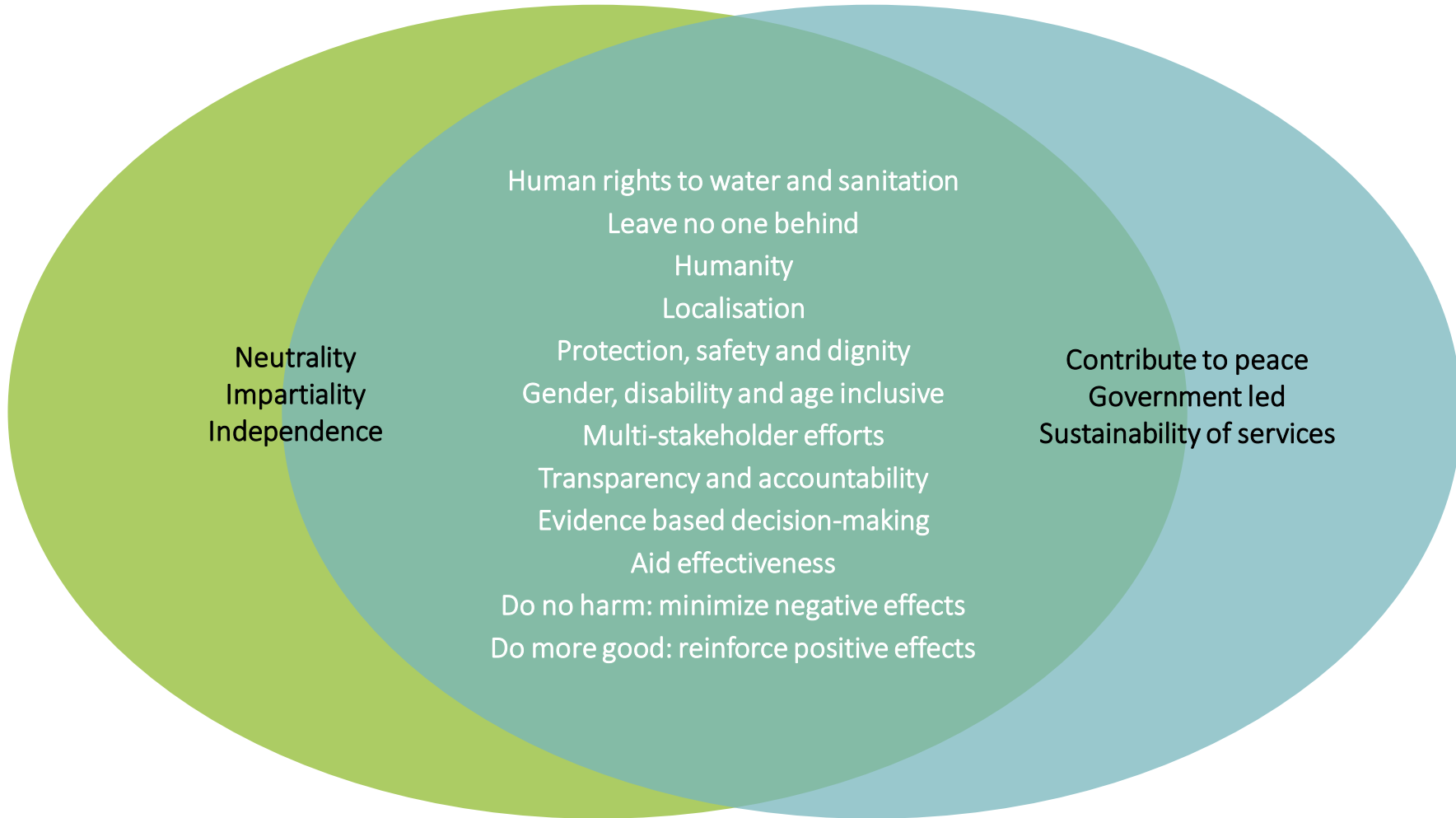
Peacebuilding reduces the risk of future humanitarian crisis

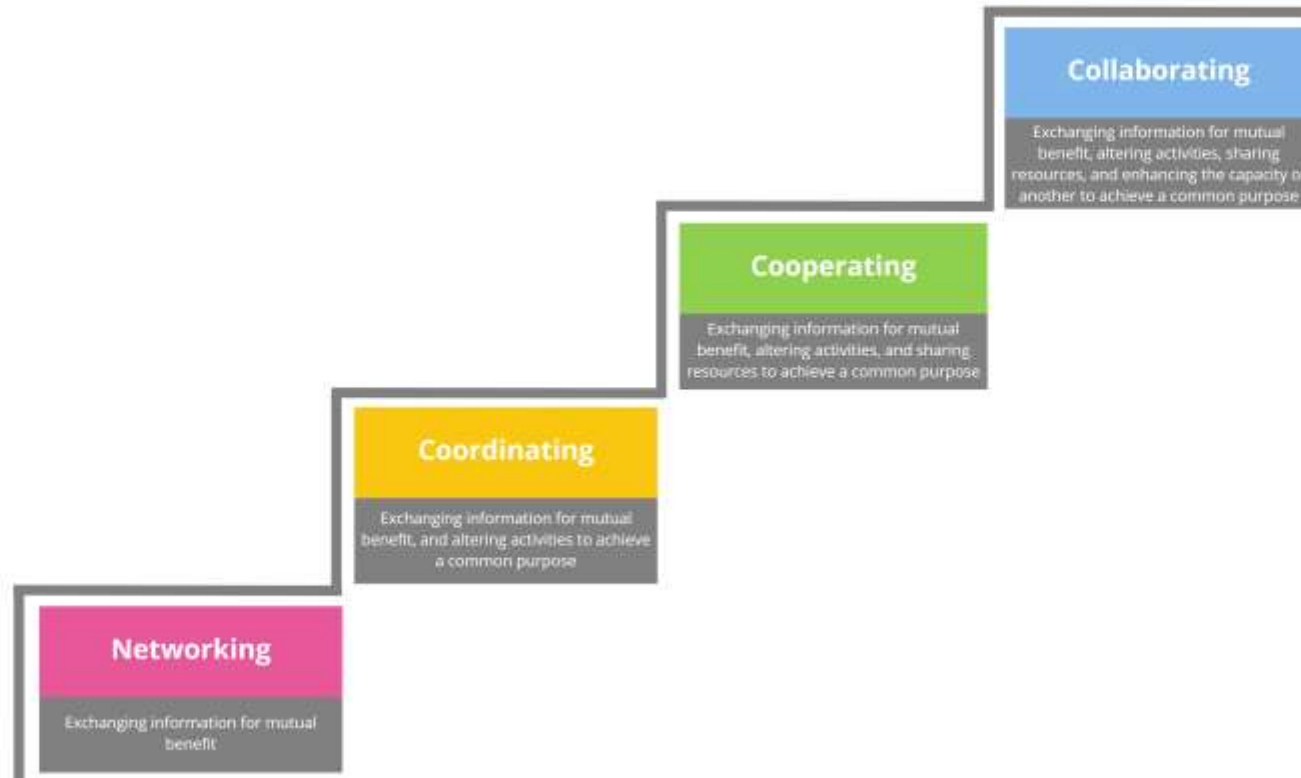

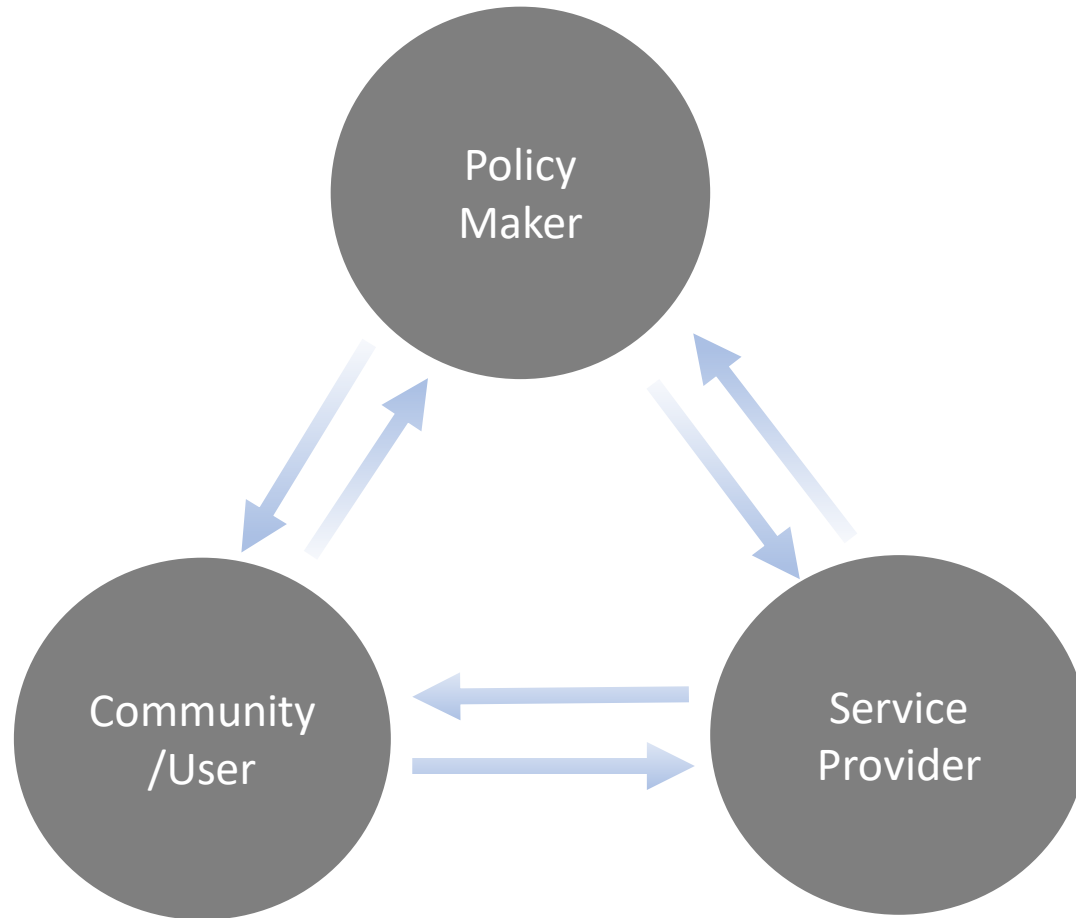
Collaboration Continuum

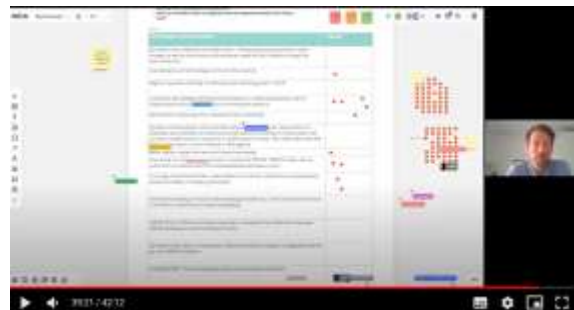

Case Study: “A multi-sectoral approach to eliminating cholera in Haiti, linking Hum-Dev”



- Haiti merged humanitarian response and development actions across the WASH and Health Sectors, and at all levels of gov't
- Haiti's National Plan for the Elimination of Cholera 2013-22
 - Axis 1: Coordination
 - Axis 2: Early detection, preparedness and response
 - Axis 3: Prevention through long-term WASH and health interventions in cholera hotspots
