Workstream description

To achieve the goals set in the 2030 cholera roadmap, a very strong engagement of the WASH sector will be needed both for emergency response and long-term cholera prevention.

In order to mobilize WASH partners and donors, it is crucial to define a **common approach** for the WASH sector in National Cholera Control Plans (**NCPs**) and how to **identify** needs, **implement** activities, and **measure progresses** of WASH interventions over time.

WASH in NCPs sub-group will help define GTFCC guidance and tools on how the WASH sector should identify, prioritize, plan and implement WASH interventions in cholera hotspots.

The conception and execution of an NCP can be divided into four phases:

- Inception
- Development
- Implementation
- Monitoring & Reporting
