# CASE STUDIES

## Workstream description / objectives

To achieve the goals set in the 2030 cholera roadmap, a very strong engagement of the WASH sector will be needed in particular for long-term cholera prevention.

In order to mobilize WASH partners and donors to invest in cholera hotspots, **it is paramount to demonstrate that “WASH works”, and to tell inspiring stories.**

**Case studies could be a powerful tool** to disseminate GTFCC guidance implementation, encourage experience sharing from different partners in the field, synthesize lessons learned, and communicate on successful approaches with WASH partners and donors.

## Workplan

Main steps	Detailed activity
Define scope / format	Agree on the objective / scope / format for case studies with other sub-groups such as Advocacy (merge this group with the advocacy group ?)
Test the usefulness	Identify initial list of existing stories that could be formatted into GTFCC case studies, contact partners and develop of a limited number (3) of initial case-studies content to test the usefulness of this work.
Call for contributions	Call for contribution to all GTFCC members for the development of additional case-studies
