**STEP 2:** Identify COMPETENCIES that are needed to implement those activities

**STEP 3:** Look with other GTFCC members for existing trainings and if they would respond to the need for COMPETENCIES

**STEP 4:** Identify GAPS and share those gaps with the rest of GTFCC members; Ask for partners support to develop those trainings
