- Lack of timeliness (published second semester year +1)
- Lack of granularity

- Historical coverage (up to 1950s)
- Available in the public domain
- Official

- Document general trends
- Monitor Global Roadmap targets

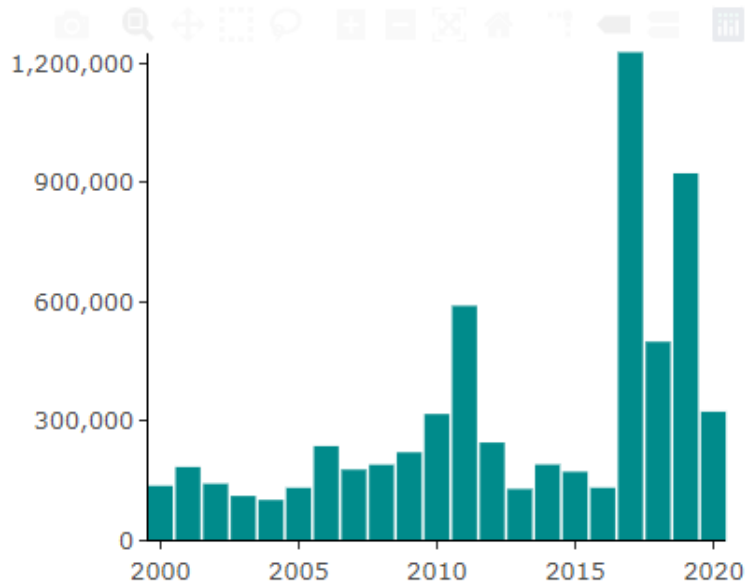

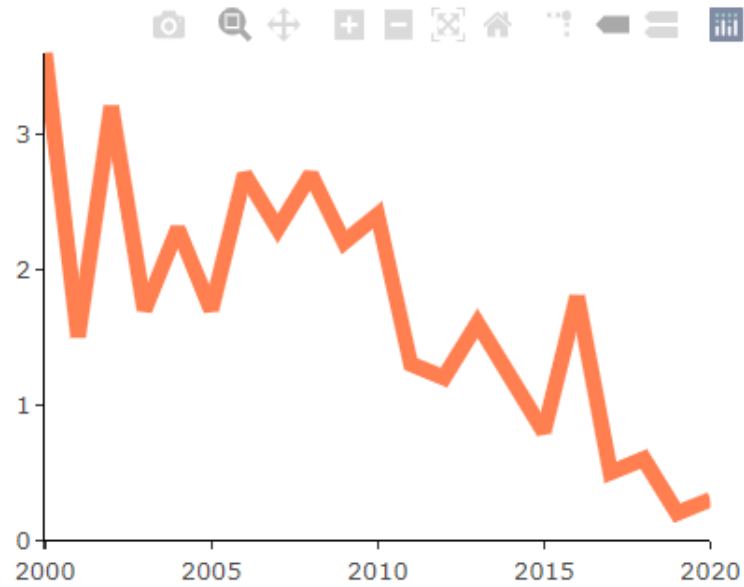

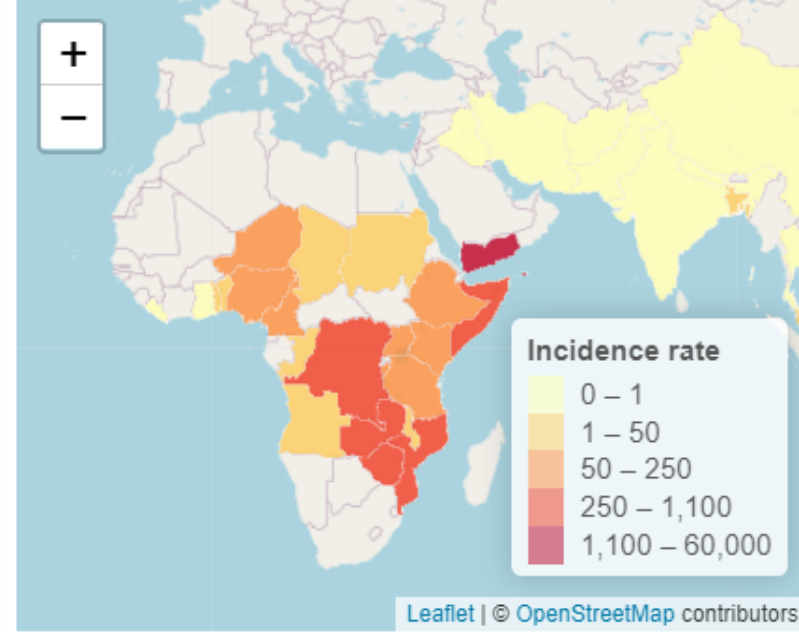
Number of cholera cases reported to WHO

Incidence rate of autochthonous cholera [2018-2020]



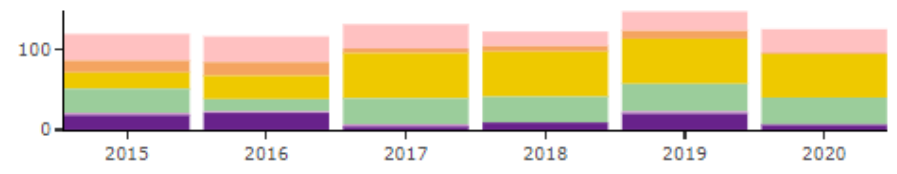

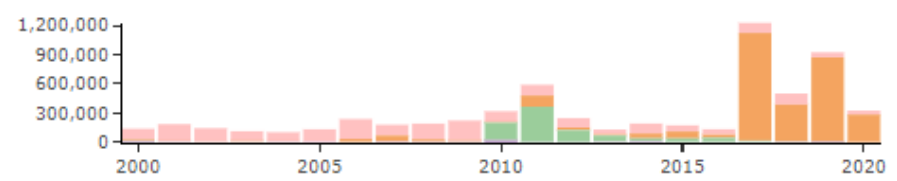

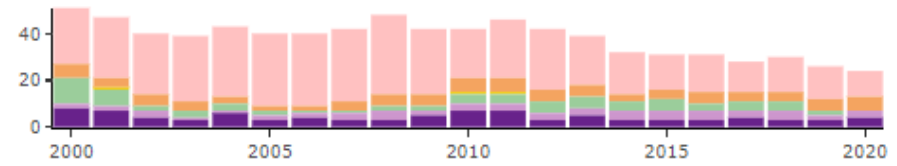

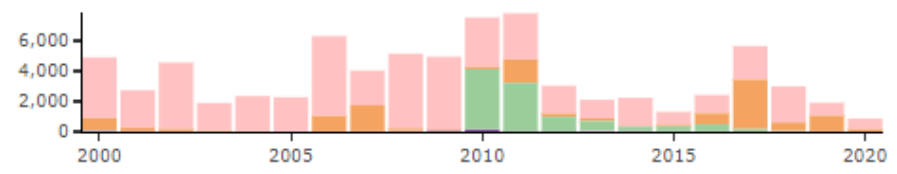
Number of reported autochthonous cases



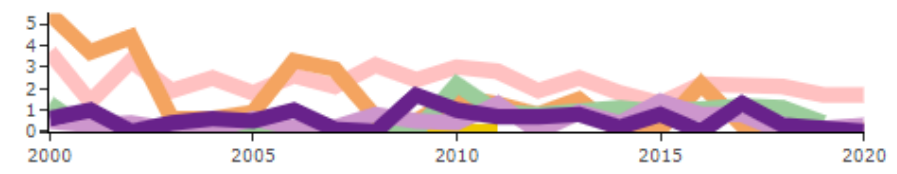
Countries with reported autochthonous cases

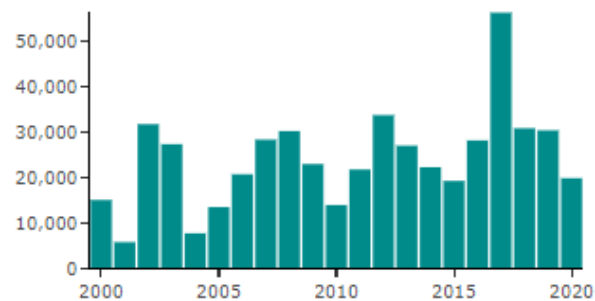

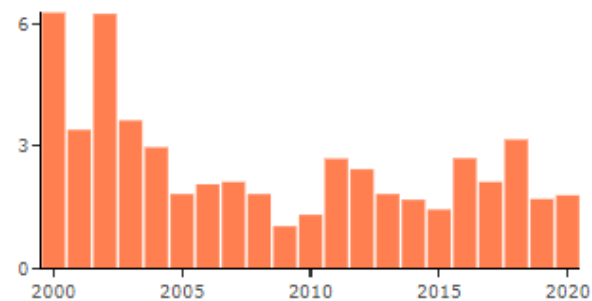
