
CHOLERA NOTIFICATION CASES

ACHIEVEMENTS AND GOOD PRACTICES	CHALLENGES AND SOLUTIONS
Establishment of Technical Working Groups at Central, Provincial and District levels throughout the country;	 Engagement of technical and political-administrative actors to cholera problem; Creation of Technical Working Groups in all provinces and advocacy at all levels
Conducting Technical Workshops on cholera data analysis with the participation of all relevant actors of all operational levels of action;	 Cholera surveillance system in routine health services with low sensitivity for capturing cholera cases — Underestimation of cases; Inference of cases of cholera among severe cases of acute diarrhea in adults; Mapping of High-Risk Zones; Implementation of an enhanced surveillance program in one of the most important hotspots(Nampula).
Conduct cholera hotspot mapping and high-risk cholera zones in the lowest administrative division across the country;	Lack of geographic data (population, geolocation data) detailed down to the lowest administrative division level; • Use of approximate data
