# 1. UPDATE ON CHOLERA SITUATION

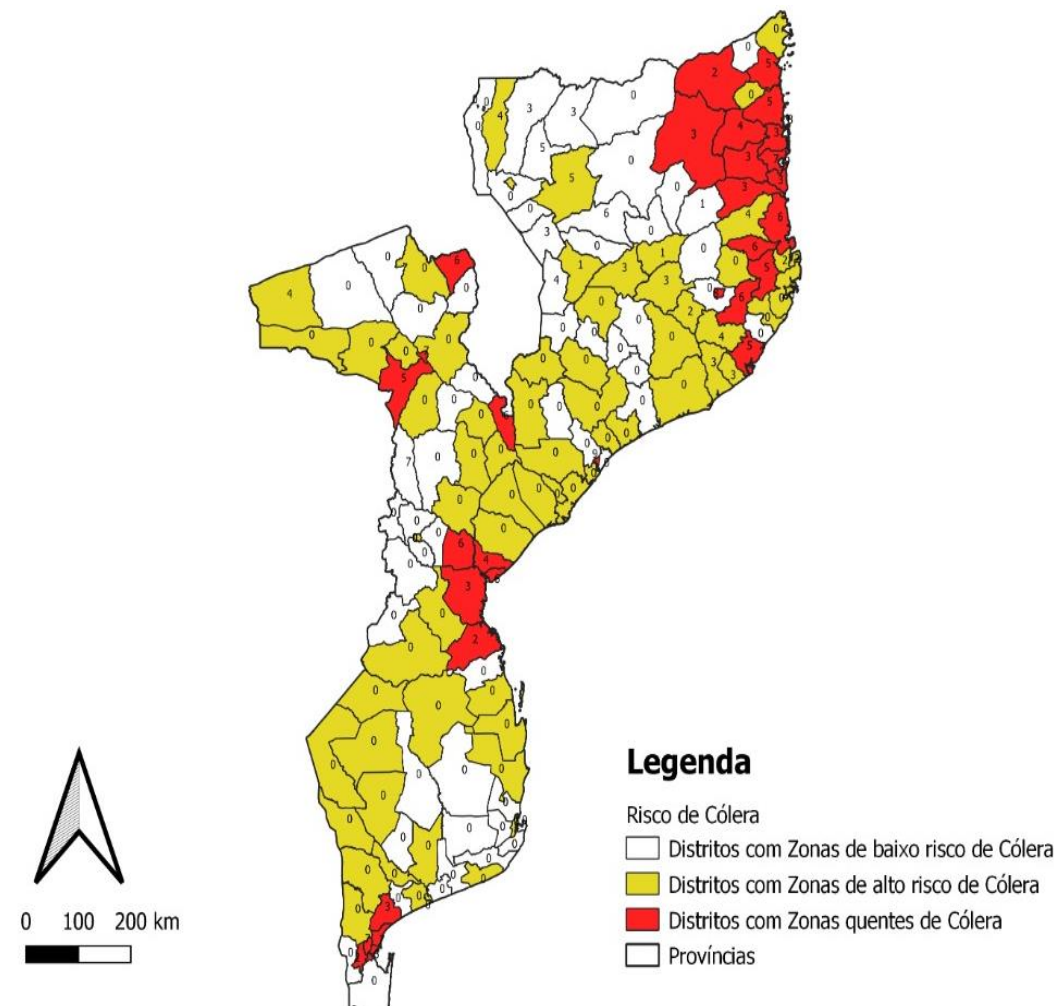
## CHOLERA NOTIFICATION CASES

- 2016 – 2021 = 36,716 cases
- 2020-2021 = 16,073 (44%), Inc. 52.13/100.000 hab, CFR 0.2%
  - Cabo Delgado
  - Nampula
  - Sofala

## 2. KEY ACHIEVEMENTS AND MAIN CHALLENGES

ACHIEVEMENTS AND GOOD PRACTICES	CHALLENGES AND SOLUTIONS
Establishment of Technical Working Groups at Central, Provincial and District levels throughout the country;	Engagement of technical and political-administrative actors to cholera problem; <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Creation of Technical Working Groups in all provinces and advocacy at all levels</li></ul>
Conducting Technical Workshops on cholera data analysis with the participation of all relevant actors of all operational levels of action;	Cholera surveillance system in routine health services with low sensitivity for capturing cholera cases – Underestimation of cases; <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Inference of cases of cholera among severe cases of acute diarrhea in adults;</li><li>• Mapping of High-Risk Zones;</li><li>• Implementation of an enhanced surveillance program in one of the most important hotspots(Nampula).</li></ul>
Conduct cholera hotspot mapping and high-risk cholera zones in the lowest administrative division across the country;	Lack of geographic data (population, geolocation data) detailed down to the lowest administrative division level; <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Use of approximate data</li></ul>
