



BRIEF HISTORY OF THE COUNTRY SUPPORT PLATFORM (CSP)





- Cholera affected countries had called for additional technical support from the GTFCC to roll out the Global Roadmap at national level
- Establishment of the CSP was endorsed at the GTFCC annual meeting in 2019 as an operational arm of the GTFCC and hosted at the IFRC Geneva, under the Health & Care Department
- Seed funding for first 3 years was received from Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation (BMGF), with additional funding from the Swiss Agency for Development & Cooperation (SDC)
- Wellcome Trust is funding a position of a Senior Research Officer, to support the cholera research agenda, hosted at the British Red Cross office in London

Outcome 3


Multisectoral technical support and capacity building provided to countries

The CSP provides multisectoral operational support as well as advocacy, coordination, and guidance necessary for countries to develop, fund, implement, and monitor their NCPs effectively.

The CSP approach is to work closely with countries to understand context specific needs and adapt the support accordingly.

- •Developed processes, tools and supporting materials to operationalise the GTFCC guidance for National Cholera Plans. Materials available to countries/ partners. Additional tools under development
- •Establishment of pool of technical experts to support countries in achieving GTFCC Global Roadmap 2030 goals. Database of consultants by expertise available for facilitating field deployments
- Contributed to the multi-partner cholera preparedness and response trainings targeted at national authorities from 25 countries, led by WHO AFRO
- •Supported **OCV** specific trainings led by WHO, CDC and Gavi. Trainings were conducted in 3 countries, covering a range of angloand francophone countries.

Advocating and lobbying government to have cholera affected areas as a priority in their annual national-level programmes

(via WASH services)

Advocating and lobbying government to maximize national resources by prioritizing basic human rights and the SDGs

(via WASH
investment)

Global partners to play a key role on governance and accountability by monitoring national budget allocations, jointstatements and commitments made publicly by respective governments

Call to actions on international development targets and official aid should prioritise WASH, by increasing contribution to the WASH sector





Sustained functionality

- The CSP has raised resources to continue its work beyond the first phase of funding
- The CSP continues to accompany current countries and can expand its support to additional countries

Outcome

- Budgeted NCPs –
 aligned with Global
 Roadmap developed
 with 8 countries
- Support provided to fund and initiate implementation of NCPs in CSP countries
- A mechanism for reporting progress in countries in place
