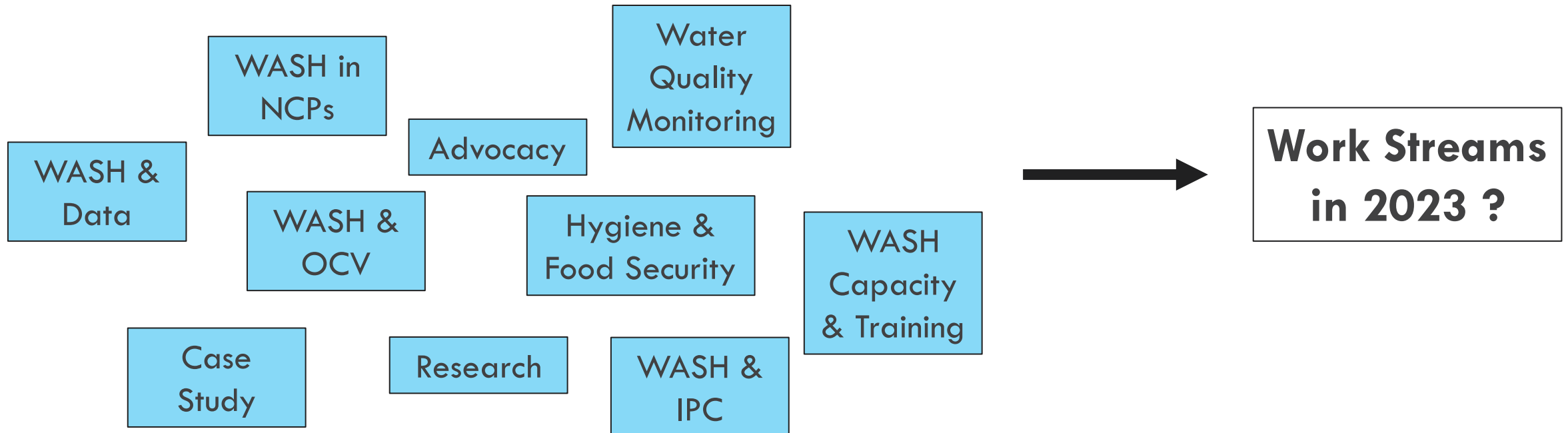

- No tangible outcomes

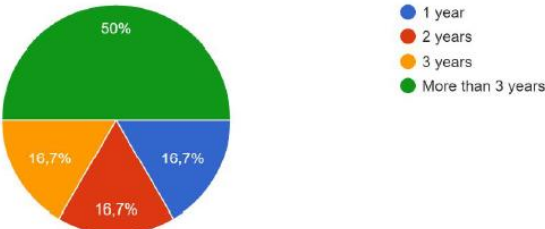

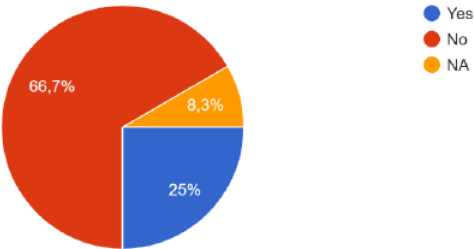

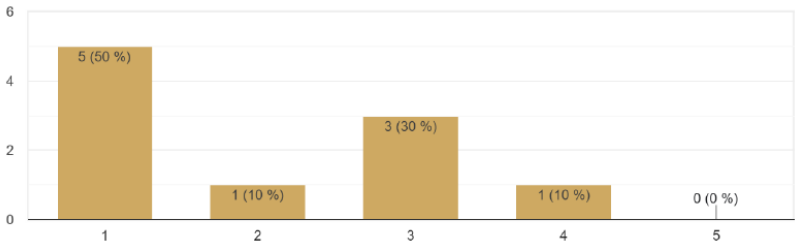
Nb of meeting/year

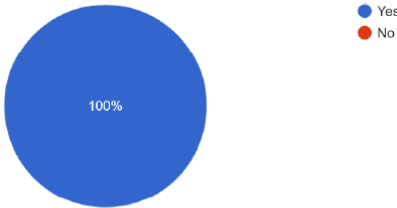
WS interaction (with other WS)

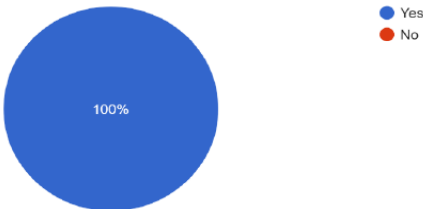

Refine the vision: *How we, as a WWG, can we contribute to helping the GTFCC achieve its goal (Roadmap)*

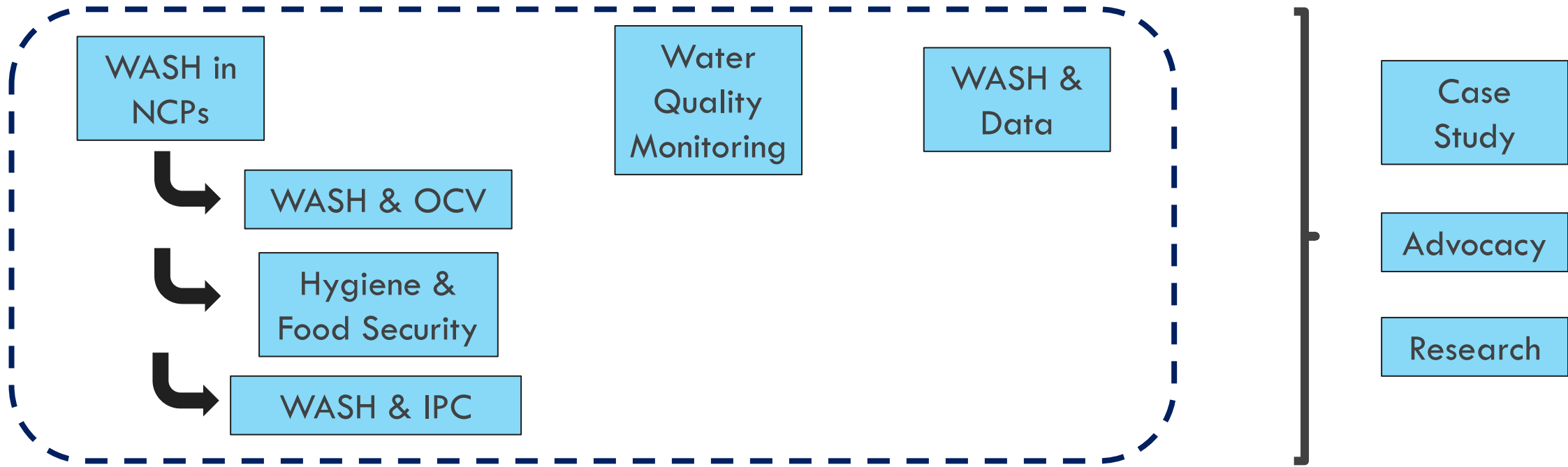
Overall feedback

- *Link between humanitarian and development (bridge), how to improve that (advocacy) - Have donors/partners more flexible (no see the problem as only development or emergency).*

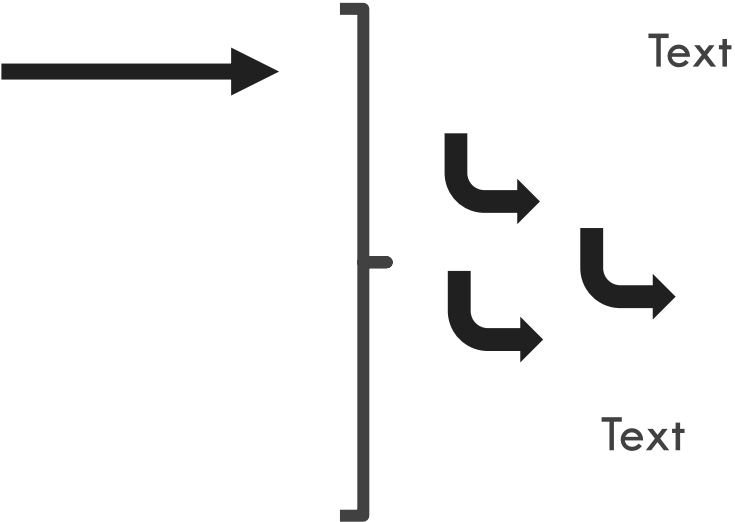
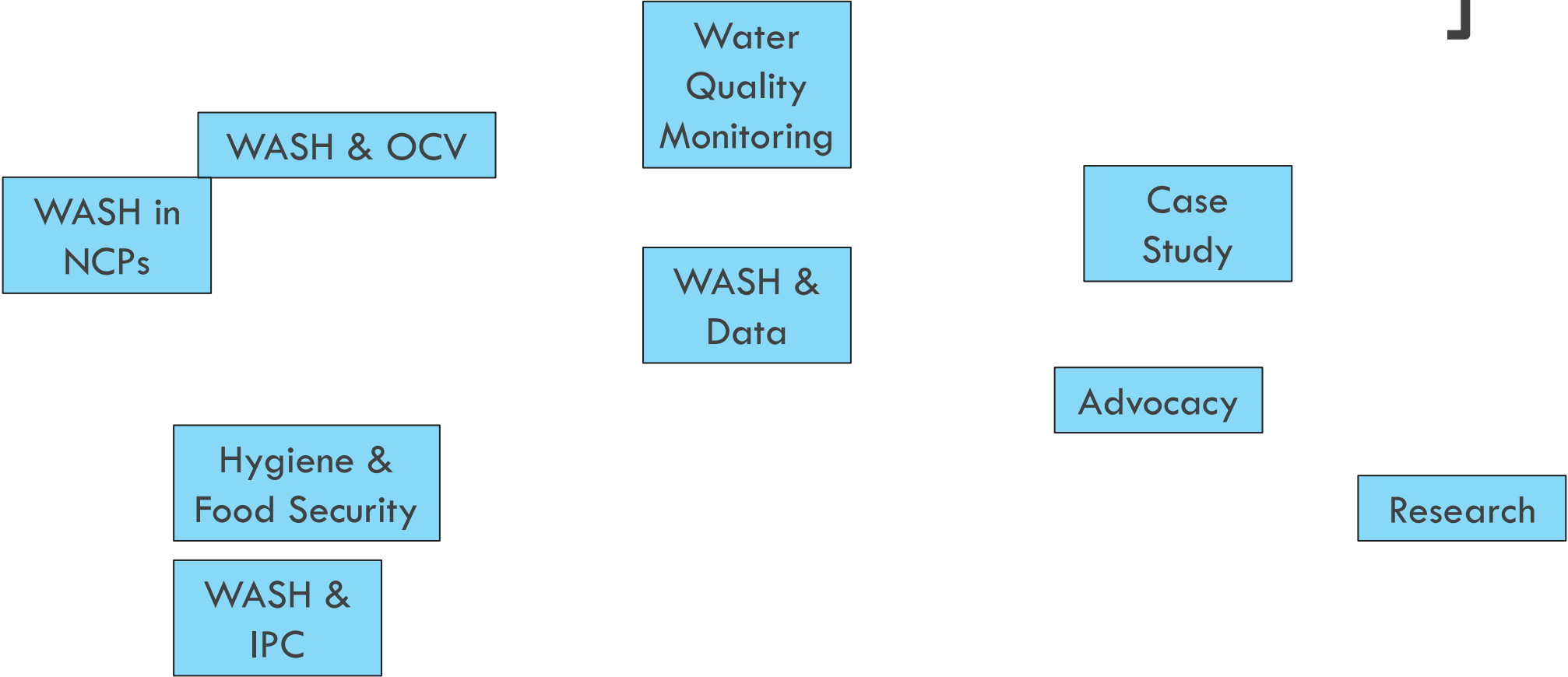
