
OCV WORKING GROUP UPDATE

OCV WG: Major achievements 2022-2023

- 16 cholera endemic countries trained on OCV requests and campaigns in AFR and SEAR
- 1 country submitted multi-year OCV request for preventive campaigns to Gavi
- OCV allocation framework guidance development initiated
- Continued improvements to the interactive dashboard
- Prioritization of cholera PAMIs for OCV guidance and tool piloted in DRC and during Nepal workshop
- Initiated systematic review of 2-dose and 1dose OCV effectiveness and efficacy

Cholera endemic countries trained on OCV requests and campaigns



OCV WG: Priorities for 2023-2024

- Implement OCV request and campaign planning workshop in the Eastern Mediterranean Region
- Support countries with development of multi-year plans for preventive campaigns: 4 countries prioritized for 2023
- Development of the supply allocation framework & SOP for preventive campaigns
- Develop tools and guidance to ensure standardized M&E of OCV campaigns: monitor and revise, as needed, dashboard and PAMI prioritization tool
- Continue to support more countries to determine their 2023-2026 OCV forecast

Challenges/call to action

- Limited vaccine stockpile that led to the decision to temporally provide 1 dose instead of 2 doses for outbreak response
- Delayed implementation of emergency campaigns
- Lack of engagement from EPI for OCV campaign implementation
