# GTFCC STRUCTURATION

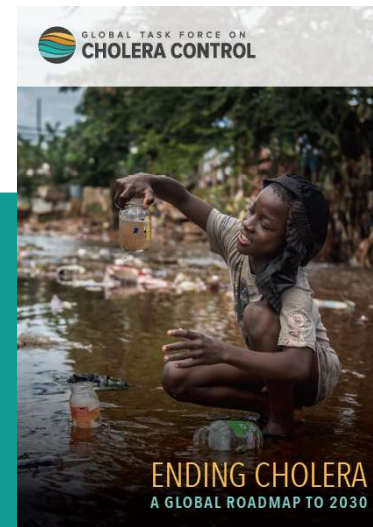
1992: Start of the Global Cholera Control Task Force (WHO)

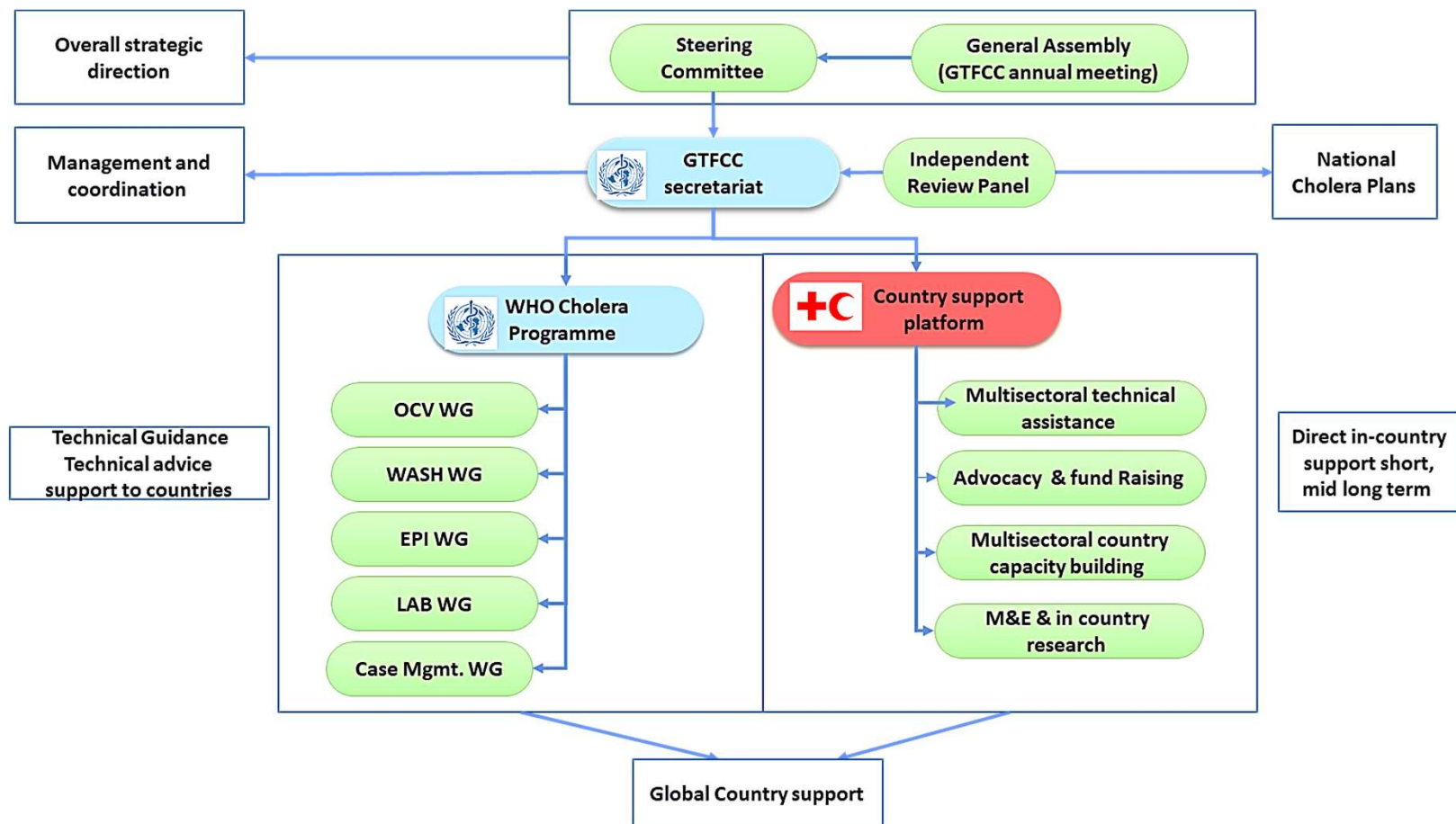

# WORKING GROUPS - PRIORITIES (I)

	2024-2025 Priorities
EPI	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Identification of priority areas for multisectoral interventions (PAMIs)</li><li>• Publish Translated Versions of the 2024 Surveillance Guidelines + develop online training modules</li><li>• Advance on cholera-free status identification mechanism</li><li>• Promote Key Concepts in Scientific Journals and collaborate on data standards</li></ul>
LAB	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Develop a laboratory manual for testing for cholera.</li><li>• Review and update existing guidance on genomics and cholera testing.</li><li>• Refine the laboratory capacity assessment tools and resume execution of assessments in priority countries.</li><li>• Develop and execute training plan and package for ToT on diagnostics for cholera.</li><li>• Support the work of WHO, GAVI and partners to strengthen diagnostics through the development of an evaluation protocol for cholera molecular diagnostics.</li><li>• Develop job aid <i>Stool Specimen Collection</i> and job aid <i>Preservation of Isolates of Vibrio cholerae</i>.</li></ul>

# WORKING GROUPS - PRIORITIES (II)

	2024-2025 Priorities
CM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Improve access to timely diarrhoea treatment by reviewing community treatment models and their strengths and weaknesses.</li><li>• Develop tools and training for setting up and managing ORPs.</li><li>• Enhance data collection during cholera outbreaks based on GTFCC recommendations and complete a review on rehydration of children with SAM by Q3 2024.</li><li>• Continue studying the use of antibiotics in cholera management, focusing on transmission impact and antimicrobial resistance.</li><li>• Evaluate recent large cholera outbreaks to identify bottlenecks and improve future guidance.</li></ul>
OCV	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Support countries on the pathway to implement the OCV component of their NCP (preventive campaigns). Target for this period are Zambia, Malawi, and Nepal.</li><li>• Develop tools and guidance documents, where needed, to ensure standardized M&amp;E of OCV campaigns and to improve campaign quality.</li><li>• Continue to support more countries to determine their 2024-2026 OCV forecast.</li><li>• Support studies on OCV planned for 2024-2026</li><li>• Continue to support countries with emergency requests and their implementations</li><li>• Improve the dashboard including a country profile page.</li><li>• Publication of the article on OCV use 2013-2023</li></ul>

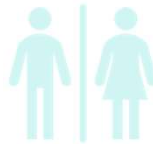

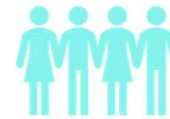
