Group Discussion

1. Each person

 - Why is this important? Evidence, examples?
 - What needs to be considered for each idea?

3. Consolidation (Note-Takers)

- Agreed consolidated ideas drafted on fresh post-its and put in place on clean board
- Hand writing some quick notes around each of the post-its on the details ‘why’ / ‘considerations’
