Axis 1: A multisectoral approach to prevent cholera in hotspots in endemic countries ^(1/2)

Vision (axis 1): in 2030, Governments and WASH partners in-country have the capacity to rapidly contain new outbreaks through WASH and multi-sectoral interventions, with limited external support.

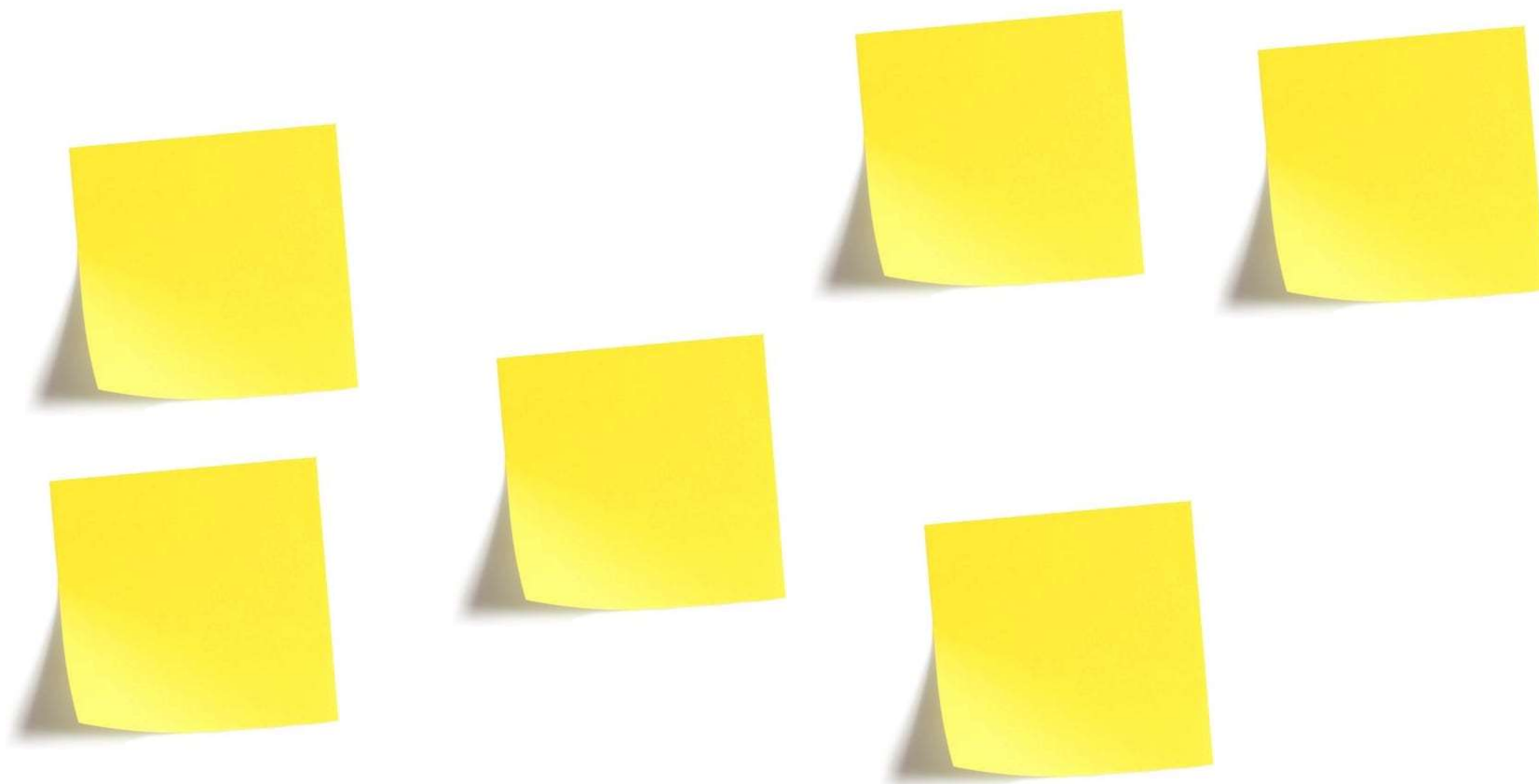


Potential activities for 2026 (from the pre-reading draft 0)

- ❑ A user-friendly guidance developed for **Water Quality Monitoring** during cholera outbreaks and piloted in priority countries.
- ❑ A GTFCC WASH guidance published to synthesize jointly agreed **WASH packages and service delivery mechanisms**.
- ❑ Priority **WASH technical notes** developed or updated by the GTFCC WASH WG, including:
 - WASH and OCV (updated)
 - Sanitation options for CTCs and ORPs (new)
 - WASH and IPC for CTCs, CTUs and ORPs (updated)
- ❑ **Emergency WASH Indicators** for a Global Cholera dashboard clearly defined and monitored in countries affected by outbreaks.
